WHAT IS A TITAN JUDGE?

SECTION 1 — INTRODUCTION

Titan Judges are responsible for maintaining fairness, consistency, professionalism, and athlete safety throughout all Titan events. Judges represent the integrity of Titan competition standards and are expected to operate with confidence, neutrality, and professionalism at all times.

Titan Judges are responsible for enforcing official event rules, validating competition standards, monitoring athlete safety, and ensuring that all teams are judged fairly across every division and competition environment.

SECTION 2 — OBJECTIVE

To maintain the integrity, safety, and professionalism of Titan competitions by enforcing official standards consistently across all events.

SECTION 3 — CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Enforce official event rules and movement standards
- Maintain athlete safety during competition
- Ensure fair and consistent judging across all divisions
- Monitor station flow and athlete progression
- Communicate penalties, warnings, and instructions clearly
- Maintain professionalism throughout all event operations

SECTION 4 — JUDGE LEVELS

TITAN JUDGE

Certified to officiate standard Titan Race competition operations, station judging, checkpoint verification, athlete flow, and basic event enforcement.

TITAN ELITE JUDGE

Advanced certification responsible for overseeing higher-level competition operations, lead judging responsibilities, dispute handling, scoring verification, and Titan Battle event coverage.

SECTION 6 — PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

Titan Judges are expected to demonstrate:

- Professionalism
- Neutrality
- Consistency
- Clear Communication
- Respect Toward Athletes & Staff
- Confidence Under Pressure
- Fair Enforcement of Rules

All judges represent the Titan brand and are expected to maintain high operational standards throughout every event.

JUDGE CONDUCT & PROFESSIONALISM

SECTION 1 — OBJECTIVE

To ensure all Titan Judges maintain professionalism, consistency, neutrality, and respect throughout all competition operations.

SECTION 2 — PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

- Judges must remain professional at all times
- Judges represent the Titan brand during all events
- Judges must maintain neutrality across all teams and divisions
- Personal bias or favoritism is strictly prohibited
- Judges must remain calm and composed under pressure

SECTION 3 — ATHLETE INTERACTION

- Judges must communicate clearly and respectfully with athletes
- Instructions and penalties must be delivered professionally
- Unsportsmanlike arguments or confrontations are prohibited
- Judges must avoid unnecessary verbal conflict with competitors
- Athlete concerns should be escalated professionally when necessary

SECTION 5 — CONSISTENCY & FAIRNESS

- All teams must be judged equally under official Titan standards
- Judges must apply penalties and rulings consistently
- Competition standards must remain unchanged throughout the event
- Safety rulings always take priority over competition flow



SECTION 4 — APPEARANCE & PRESENTATION

- Judges must wear official Titan Judge apparel during all competition operations
- Judges must maintain a clean and professional appearance
- Judges should remain alert, attentive, and engaged during all heats
- Phones and unnecessary distractions are prohibited during active judging

SECTION 6 — PROFESSIONAL EXPECTATIONS

Titan Judges are expected to operate with:

- Integrity
- Professionalism
- Confidence
- Consistency
- Leadership
- Fairness
- Respect

SCORING & EVENT OPERATIONS

SECTION 1 — OBJECTIVE

To ensure all scoring, timing, and event operations are managed consistently and professionally throughout Titan competitions.

SECTION 2 — LIVE SCORE ENTRY

- All official scores must be entered into the Titan dashboard immediately after heat completion
- Judges are responsible for verifying score accuracy before submission
- Score submissions automatically affect official rankings and placements
- Incorrect score submissions must be escalated immediately to the Head Judge

SECTION 3 — TIMING PROCEDURES

- Judges may use:
 - Titan dashboard stopwatch
 - Mobile stopwatch
 - Approved physical stopwatch
- Final official times must always be entered into the Titan dashboard system
- Timing verification must be completed before score submission

SECTION 4 — INTERNET & DEVICE REQUIREMENTS

- Judges must maintain stable internet access throughout competition operations
- Devices used for scoring must remain sufficiently charged during event operations
- Operational delays caused by connectivity issues should be escalated immediately
- Judges should confirm dashboard functionality before competition begins

SECTION 5 — ATHLETE FLOW & CHECKPOINTS

- Judges must verify checkpoint completion before athlete progression
- Transition bands and station completion must be confirmed before advancement
- Teams must follow the official competition route at all times
- Judges may temporarily pause athlete progression for operational or safety concerns

SECTION 6 — EVENT OPERATIONS

- Judges are responsible for maintaining organized station flow
- Equipment should remain competition-ready between heats
- Operational issues should be communicated immediately to event leadership
- Judges must remain attentive throughout all competition operations

SAFETY & EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

SECTION 1 — OBJECTIVE

To ensure all Titan competitions maintain safe operational standards for athletes, judges, staff, and spectators.

SECTION 2 — ATHLETE SAFETY

- Judges may immediately stop athletes for unsafe movement or dangerous conduct
- Athlete safety always overrides competition flow
- Unsafe equipment usage must be corrected immediately
- Judges should remain alert for signs of injury, exhaustion, or medical distress

SECTION 3 — MEDICAL ESCALATION

- Medical staff should be notified immediately during emergencies
- Judges must communicate injury situations clearly and calmly
- Competition areas should remain clear during medical response situations
- Head Judge and event leadership must be informed immediately

SECTION 5 — ENVIRONMENTAL & CROWD SAFETY

- Judges should monitor surrounding competition areas for hazards
- Spectators must remain outside designated competition zones
- Emergency pathways and operational walkways must remain clear
- Operational safety concerns should be escalated immediately



SECTION 4 — EQUIPMENT SAFETY

Titan Judges:

- Damaged or unsafe equipment must be reported immediately
- Competition equipment should be inspected before each heat
- Unsafe station conditions may result in temporary competition delays
- Judges should ensure station areas remain clear and organized

SECTION 6 — EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Titan Judges are expected to demonstrate:

- Judges must remain calm during emergency situations
- Competition flow may be paused for safety concerns
- Judges should follow instructions from medical staff and event leadership
- All emergency incidents should be documented
